Venutai Chavan College NCC Unit Organises Awareness Programme on ‘Jal Jeevan Mission’

Karad, January 23, 2025 — The NCC sub-unit of Venutai Chavan College, Karad, organised an awareness programme on the Government of India’s flagship initiative, Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), under the theme “Har Ghar Jal.”

The chief guest for the programme, Prof. Pandharpatte from the Department of Geography and Environmental Science, delivered an insightful presentation on the objectives and progress of the Jal Jeevan Mission.
