

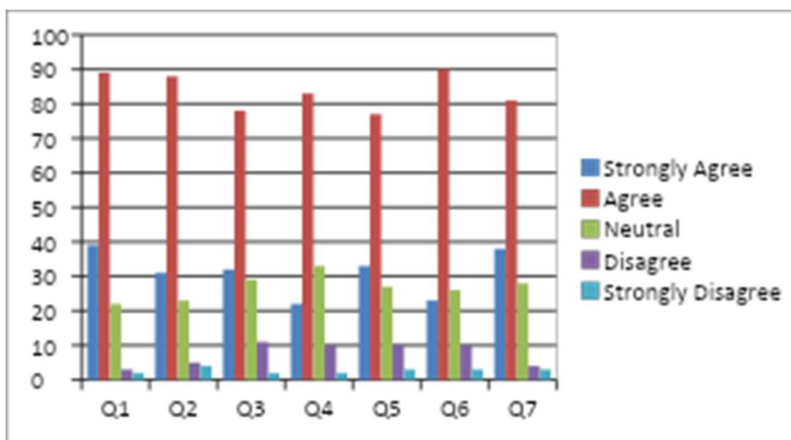
Feedback Analysis

 7. Satisfied about current syllabus

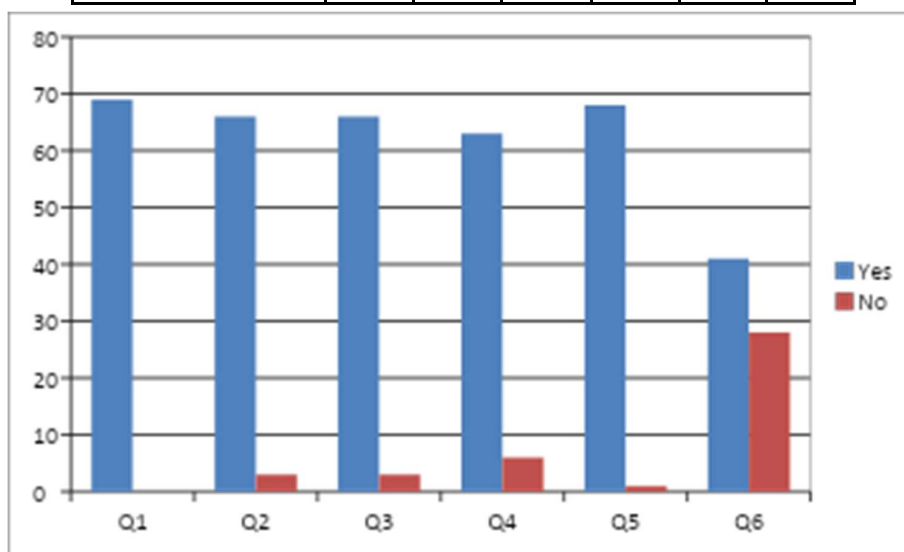

6. Do you expect any change in curriculum?

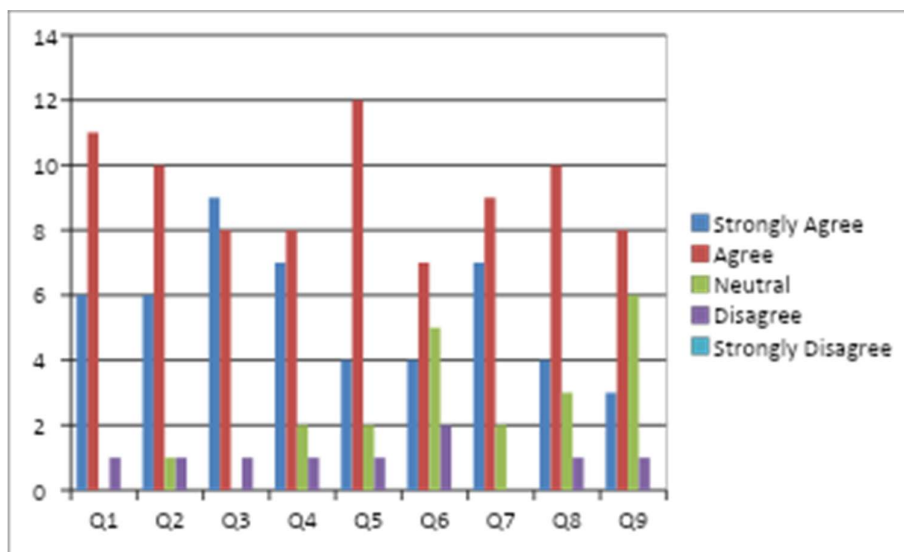
